This Policy Statement outlines our commitment to implementing and continually improving an Information Security Management System (ISMS) in accordance with ISO/IEC 27001:2022 standard.

- Establishing, implementing, maintaining, and continually improving an Information Security Management System (ISMS) to ensure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of information assets.
- Protecting sensitive information from unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction.
- Ensuring that access to information assets is granted based on the principle of least privilege and is strictly controlled.
- Implementing appropriate technical, organisational, and physical security measures to safeguard information assets.
- Complying with all relevant laws, regulations, and contractual obligations related to information security.
- Providing ongoing training and awareness programs to educate employees, contractors, and third-party entities about their roles and responsibilities in maintaining information security.
- Promptly detecting, assessing, and responding to security incidents and breaches to minimise their impact on the organisation.
- Conducting regular audits and assessments to evaluate the effectiveness of the ISMS and ensure compliance with ISO/IEC 27001:2022 standards and other applicable requirements.
- Continually reviewing and improving our Information Security Policy and practices to address emerging threats and vulnerabilities.

This ISMS policy statement is reviewed annually, or as changes occur, to ensure its continued relevance and effectiveness.
